MINI

MUSICAL

(grades 1 & 2)

This program is designed as an introduction to our Junior Musical Theatre Program and is for children in grades one and two. Students will explore drama through the use of theatre games, role-playing, music and dance. Emphasis will be on building basic theatre skills, self-esteem, confidence and teamwork, all while having fun.

This program runs for approximately 12 weeks and there are two sessions a year. The class is limited to a maximum of eighteen participants per session (student-teacher ratio is 6:1).
