Teen Performing Arts Camp (for students entering grade 7 – 10)

This camp runs Monday – Thursday, for **4 weeks** beginning July 6th, from 12:30 – 2:00pm.

Week 1: Improv & Dance

Week 2: TV/Film (breaking down, analyzing and then performing scenes from age-appropriate TV or film scripts)
